Fellow Councilors, Ladies and Gentlemen, Molweni nonke ngalentsasa, Good morning, dumelang, Sanibona.

Fellow Councillors, this is a Human Rights Month which is commemorated under the theme "The Year of Charlotte Maxeke: Promoting Human Rights in the Age of COVID-19".

The theme pays tribute to the 150th anniversary of the birth of liberation struggle heroine and human rights campaigner Ms Charlotte Maxeke.

On the 21st of March the country observed the Human Rights Day, commemorating the 1960 Sharpeville massacre, where 69 people were killed while protesting against apartheid pass laws that had been imposed on black South Africans. **South Africa** has included undividable **human rights** in our own **Bill of Rights**, Chapter 2 of the Constitution of the Republic of **South Africa** which protects South Africans from human rights infringements.

Human rights are rights that everyone should have simply because they are human and these human rights are established on the basis of humanity, freedom, justice, and peace.

Due to the pandemic, we had given up basic human interactions that we once took for granted, like greeting each other with a handshake or a warm hug.

We again had to sacrifice things that are important to us, like meeting and socialising, travelling freely, attending funerals of our loved ones and being at cultural gatherings and attending religious services. But the COVID regulations or the set restrictions were, and remain, necessary for the health and safety of all of us. This Pandemic has taken a heavy toll on our economy and on our people's livelihoods.

Hounarable Mayor, we must make sure that we become a society where women and children are free from violence, their rights are protected, recognise dignity of everyone, role of every woman and child and collectively fight Gender Based Violence so as to build a better future for all.Ladies and Gentlemen, despite the interruptions in schools due to a number of COVID 19 infections, closure and being forced to adapt to the new normal of schooling, the matric class of 2020 in the midst of the Pandemic which was drastically affecting our education system managed to obtain 76.2% pass rate with a drop of 5.1% as compared to 81.3% of the previous year. Osborn High School in ward 25 made us proud by obtaining outstanding matric results with a pass rate of 98.9 %.

Fellow Councillors, the Constitution mandates us to strengthen public participation of the developmental agenda in ensuring that we regularly consult with our communities. On the 19th-23rd of April 2021 there is a scheduled EXCO IDP & Budget outreach programme which will be conducted in all 27 wards. On the **29 of April 2021** the municipality will conduct its annual Service Delivery Imbizo in ward 12 eMpoza where the Honourable Mayor will be tabling the state of the municipality address and allowing the communities to interact with the municipality. Due to COVID 19 regulations the number of attendees from various wards has been reduced so as to adhere with all the Health protocols and safety measures. We are therefore expected to attend these public interacting sessions so as to get the feel of our communities.

Lastly, I would like to urge all of us more especially the Ward Councillors to quickly attend to all rising community service delivery matters affecting our communities as and when they arise so as to minimise the number of protests and complaints. Let us continue interacting with our communities, provide feedback on the status of the municipal programmes and projects.

Molweni, Good morning, A warm welcome to you all.

We are commemorating Human Rights Day almost exactly a year since the coronavirus pandemic was declared a national disaster in our country and we prepared for a nationwide lockdown in order to contain its spread.

We have lost mothers, fathers, siblings, colleagues and friends to this deadly disease. It has taken a heavy toll on our economy and on our people's livelihoods. However be that as it may, the wrath of this pandemic still persists.

The threat of a third wave is constantly present, as is the threat of yet more new variants. Because the new variant is transmitted more easily, it has the potential to infect more people, place a greater strain on our health system and lead to a greater loss of life.

I therefore plead with all respective community leaders to please reiterate the dangers of COVID-19 to our communities. Everyone has a right to basic health services but if we continue to ignore COVID-19 protocols, then we are indirectly in conflict with our own rights.

As part of our mission towards socio-economic emancipation and recovery during this COVID-19 period, Umzimvubu Local Municipality will host a Human Rights Day Youth Community Dialogue under the theme "Youth Socio-Economic Renewal and Nation Building" at Shinta Community Hall.

Among those that are invited to attend are critical stakeholders such as youth sectors in Business and Agriculture, Chapter 9 Institutions, NYDA, SEFA and SEDA. The programme will be held under very strict COVID-19 health protocols and will only permit 100 participants inside the hall. The programme will be held on the 30th March 2021 at 10:00 AM.

Madam Speaker; on a more pleasing note, the Municipality has invested more than R 500 000.00 on a pilot project for the construction of 3 houses meant for destitute families. These houses are located in the following areas:

- Ward 02: Nkanji Village

- Ward 15: Njijini Village

- Ward 19: Mvuzi Village

The Municipality remains committed to its obligation to Section 26 of the South African Constitution. This means that adequate shelter is provided to deserving citizens.

Although the construction of houses lies with the Provincial Department of Human Settlements, Umzimvubu Local Municipality saw the need to urgently intervene and to provide decent living conditions to these communities.

Fellow Councillors; Indeed there's a good story to tell. On the 3rd – 8th March 2021 Umzimvubu Local Municipality together with SASSA handed over new school uniform across schools within Umzimvubu Local Municipality. More than 300 students benefitted from this programme and restored the required dignity to underprivileged children. This is an annual programme that is conducted by the Municipality and fortunately this time around we have managed to foster good relations with our local department that also aided children with new school uniform.

 - In front of Hlaya Butchery there is an illegal dumping
 - > In front of Sirhonyonyo there is an Illegal dumping
 - > There are broken bottles in the side curb bin in fron of S.S.S bottle store
 - > In N2 most side curb bins are filled with soil which is not dealt with
- There has been a problem with the collection of waste which latter was resolved by the Solid waste management Foreman
- These are the areas that complied after the intervention by environmental educators:
 - > Hardware city, Jabulani hardware and Masakhane has complied
 - > The Street vendors are now complying with proper waste management
 - > The Sironyonyo parking is now cleared and no more vehicles are being parked for mechanical reasons
- These are the non-compliant areas:
 - Behind the old Cashbuild the waste is still escalating
 - > Behind spargs garage remains a nuisance
 - > S.S.S has not stopped dumping broken bottles into the side curb bins

Recommendations

- The shops that are non-compliant should be shut until they have resolved the problems caused by them or make requisitions as to how they would remedy
- ❖ All side curb bins must be attended once every week
- All damaged side curb bins must be registered for replacement
- Skip bins must be collected twice a week
