COUNCIL SPEECH DELIVERED BY THE HONOURABLE MAYOR COUNCILLOR SK MNUKWA DURING A COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON THE 28 MAY 2021.

Madam Speaker,

Chief Whip

Fellow Honourable Councillors

Traditional Leaders present today,

Municipal Manager and Senior Managers

Ladies and Gentlemen

Ndiyanibulisa ngegama le ntuthukho kunye negama leNkosi yethu uYesu Krestu, Amen.

Ladies and Gentlemen; as the country approaches another COVID-19 wave this winter, I can affirm that Umzimvubu is in a much better position than where it was a year ago.

This being the number of vaccine registrations that have been recorded for Umzimvubu across KwaBhaca and EmaXesibeni.

The Municipality is currently seating at 5644 registrations and has since been identified as the Municipality with the highest number of registrations in the district.

Madame Speaker; On the 18th of May 2021, I was joined by the Alfred Nzo District Municipality Executive Mayor, Cllr Sixolile Mehlomakhulu together with Dr Tshoba who is the Clinical Manager at the Madzikane ka Zulu Memorial Hospital, to assess the state of readiness of the vaccination site.

This we did swiftly and can also confirm that the vaccination site is fully compliant and ready to service our people.

Let me also add that on the same day, I received my first 'jab' of the Johnson and Johnson COVID-19 vaccine. This we did together with the Executive Mayor and we further urge more residents to get registered and be part of this historical vaccination programme.

Fellow Councillors; in the midst of this pandemic, we are faced with yet a far more discriminatory societal illness. Gender Based Violence (GBV) is our countries worst enemy and it continues to persist amongst our communities.

This past week we were honoured with a visit from the Social Development Deputy-Minister, Hon. HI Bogopane-Zulu. The visit was in aid of assessing the conditions of the safe home in Mtshazi Village.

This community-based project was initiated by women from the area in trying to respond to these community challenges affecting in the main; women and children as victims of crime and violence.

The ongoing violence in our area prompted the South African Government to investigate the root and underlying causes of Gender Based Violence, and further prompted a more focused response to mitigating violence against women and children through the safe home initiative.

Madam Speaker; our challenges as Umzimvubu Local Municipality are not in any way different than that of our neighbours. However the difference is in the manner in which we develop mechanisms to resolve our challenges.

With this said, on the 21st May 2021, I was part of a panel of Mayors across the Eastern Cape Province that were hosted by SALGA on various community media platforms.

This initiative comes at a time when the sector is preparing for local government elections amidst a sustained local government pessimism which

can be attributed to a lack thereof to inform the public and appropriately profile the good work that the sector has contributed towards the significant improvement in terms of the proportion of households that have access to water, electricity, housing and the ongoing improvement of the roads infrastructure.

This was a prudent opportunity to share our achievements, milestones and challenges that we have experienced as a Municipality since 2016.

Water and sanitation were among the challenges across the Eastern Cape Municipalities, whilst illegal water and electricity connections topped the list of challenges.

Ladies and Gentlemen; as part of the 'Asimanga Siyaqhuba' Service Delivery Campaign, our communication unit will be visiting all wards and will be profiling at least 3 projects per ward.

This will be aired on the 'Informer' digital TV and will also be linked to our official Municipal Facebook page.

The initiative known as "Thetha Councillor" will see Ward Councillors talking about their ward based projects in an effort to maximise communication with our stakeholders and communities. Indeed Asimanga Siyaqhuba.

On that note, ngomhla weshumi elinesibini kwinyanga kaCanzibe kwakulomnyaka umiyo, siye sanikezela ngeholo ngokusesikweni kuluntu lwakwaward 25 neyakhiwe kwilali yaseMangqamzeni KwaBhaca.
