Molweni. Good morning. A warm welcome to you all.

As we continue to commemorate Nelson Mandela Month, let us be reminded that positive change begins with small actions.

As each person acts, they fuel momentum towards positive change, raising awareness and expanding the reach of Mr Mandela's values – fighting injustice, helping people in need and practicing reconciliation. This is a crucial lever to opportune, if we are to ever become united.

Communities across the country are badly affected by the spread of Covid-19, which has hit our economy to its knees, causing new social and economic challenges whilst exacerbating the old ones.

But, there is hope. Because on a scale never seen before, individuals and groups are finding ways to help those who are less fortunate.

We have seen this act through the Municipal solidarity fund, whereby Councillors, Senior Managers, Traditional Leaders and Strategic Stakeholders came together and contributed towards a fruitful cause.
