A bahlali kwa ward 25, eMaphakama, kwaBhaca baza kufumana indlela esemgangathweni emva kokulungiswa kwendlela ekulelali. Kutshanje Usodolophu kaMasipala wase-Umzimvubu ujikeleze ii-projekti nanje ngokuba equkumbela nyaka mali ka 2022-2023. Ezi projekthi ziquka indlela yase Maphakama ephantsi kwe sebe leZiseko Nocwangciso lalomasipala ngen-jongo zokujonga ugangan-gatho kwanomgama osele uhanjiwe. Le ndlela eyenziwa yinkam-

pani ekwaphuma kwaBhaca iza kwenza umahluko omkhulu nanje ngokuba enxulumanisa ilali ezine kwane wadi eziyingqongileyo. Umlawuli wenkampani eyakha le ndlela I Breaking Force Trading (BFT), u Mnu. Victor Gono ubulele intsebenziswano entle phakathi kwakhe noceba kunye nabahla-li ekwa chulumanciswa kukubona ukuba indlela le sele ikwinqanaba loku-ba igqitywe kungakhange kubekho kruthakruthano. Loka Gono uthe "bekulin-deke ukuba lendlela igqitywe kwisithuba senyanga

ezintandathu kodwa kungokunje sele ewuqukum-bela lomsebenzi kwinyanga njezine. Usodolophu walo masipa-la uthe "Ziprojekti zendlela ezingaphaya kumashumi amabini anesithandathu ezinziwe ngulo masipala KwaBhaca kwakunye nase MaXesibeni kulo unyakamali nekuyenye yazo le yase Maphakama. Kun-jalo nje baxhamle ngokwemisebenzi abantu base Umzimvubu kuzo kuqa nonokhontilaka. Lendlela yase Maphakama engu mgama we 5 km ivelise imisebezi kubantu aba-

lishumi elinesine. Yimali ebalelwu kwi sigidi esinamakhulu amahlanu 'R1.5 Million' yeerandi etha yabekelwa bucala ukusebenza kule Ndlela, uku-kumbele watsho lo kaN-devu. Umhlali umama umaBhayi Manciya oneminyaka engamashumi asibhozo '80 years' uthe sele iyimin-yaka lendlela ingahambeki ingakumbi xa kuthe kwanetha kuba namanzi amanizi athi adilize nez-indlu ngenxa yokuma komhlaba walommmandla. Loka Manciya uhambise wathi xasisya edolophi-

ni bekufuneka sihambe umgama ukuyakukhwela izithuthi, zexasibuya edolophini siqashe abafana ngemali ukupathiswa imithwalo. Xa kufuneka uncedo olukhawulezileyo ingakumbi kuthi bantu abasele behkulile bekubanzima kakhulu ngoba izithuthi azikwazi nokusondela. Ngoku ndiyavuya noku-ba ndingalala ndakumka ndixolile ukukubona up-huhliso nakulendawo yase Maphakama, ndithi kuMa-sipala enkosi .

LUNCUMO LODWA KUBETHELWA IZANDLA ULWAKHIWO LWEHOLO YOLUNTU I BADIBANISE

Kutshanje kulenyanga yeSilmela umasipala waseUmzimvubu undwendwile iholo yoluntu iBadibanise, kwaBhaca, ngeliyokuhlola umsebenzi owenziwego ngethuba kusakhiwa, ukanti noku-lungela ukusebenza kwe-li holo. USodolophu U Cllr Zukiswa Ndevu athe bhazalala ukuqiniseksi-sa ukusiwa kweenkonzo kuluntu lo Umzimvubu. Ukanti kolutyelelo uhamba ne ofisi yezoNxebelel-wano kwakunye necande-lo leZiseko Nocwangciso zalomaspala ngelokujonga umgama osele uhanjiwe

kwii projekti zika masipala kulo nyaka mali. Ukwakhiwa kwaleholo yoluntu eBadibanise yinqule-qhu iza emvakokuba uceba wakwa wadi 18 kwakunye noluntu lonke lwalwe wadi lathi lafaka isicelo sok-wakhelwa le holo, nezakuthi isetyenziswe njengendawo yeendibano zokuhlala. Yimali engaphaya kwiz-igidi ezibini ezinamakhu-lu amathandathu eerandi R2,6 million ethe yachithwa ngethuba lisakhiwa. Ikomiti yasekuhlaleni ejon-gene nophuhliso loluntu iyiqhwabele izandla le nkubela isithi iyibona

njengeza kwenza izinto zi-belula xa kukho isidingo sokubanjwa kweentlan-ganiso zoluntu. U-Mnu. Nkosana Ngalonkulu uthe baziva bechulumancile xa kungoku naxa belibona likwesigaba eliholo. "Besitsala nzima xa kukho izinto zokuhlala iintlan-ganiso ezidinda ngamanye amaxesha zide zingaphu-meleli ngenxa yokunga bina holo. Besisithi xa befuna ukuhlangana sisebenzise nezindlu zeetylalike". Loka Ngalonkulu weleke esithi olulakhiwo lweholo aluz-isanga nje isakhiwo koko luhphinde lwavula namathu-

ba emisebenzi batsho bax-hamla abantu balendawo. Usodolophu uceba Zu-kiswa Ndevu uthe "lo ng-umsebenzi wolulakhiwo uqalwe ngenyanga yeNk-anga kunyaka ophelileyo, yaye leholo iyenye yepro-jekthi zikamasipala ayenza kwimali ayifumana kwimali ka-MIG. Ukwenziwa kwalo kuluqilima ukuze lithabatthe ixesha elide kwaye libiyel-we lonke ukuligcina likhu-selekile. Singu Masipala sikholewa ukubakho kweli holo kuzakubakho umahlu-ko omkhulu kubahlali base Badibanise nanje ngokuba bengasazukuphinda ba-

hambe imigama emide besiya kwezinye indawo bengenalo iholo elilelabo. Ukanti enye yezinto esizing-ca ngazo singulo masipala kukuvuleka kwamathuba engqesho kubantu aban-gamashumi amabini bala-phu ekuhlaleni, nkquu un-onkontilaka obesakha le holo ngowalapha eUmzim-vubu. Oko ke kuyasincedisa ekuqinisekiseni ukuba imali yalapha eMzimvubu ijike-leza kwalapha ukuncedisa kuqoqosho nase kupuh-lisweni koosomashishini basekuhlaleni" uvakalise watsho usodolophu uCllr Ndevu.

MORE THAN 200 RESIDENTS AT EMAXESIBENI WELCOMED A NEWLY BUILT COMMUNITY HALL.

Earlier today, 27th June 2023, EmaXesibeni residents, wel comed a newly built community hall at Saphukanduku Village. The construction of this facility first commenced late last year in November 2022 and continued for 6 months until its completion date. "Today, we officially hand over this community hall, knowing that it has the potential to become a centre

of community life. It is not just a building. Within these walls, unity can be created, solutions can be found, and conversations can be held that will change many lives. Meetings can be held regardless of the weather, unlike the past when important meetings had to be cancelled on account of weather conditions", said Umzimvubu Acting Mayor, Cllr Ntombizandile Garane. "This community hall was built to

serve your needs and your family's interests. There are community halls across this Municipality, but we believe you shouldn't have to travel long distances to get to a community hall. There should be one here, right where you live. Because this is where community happens", said Cllr Garane. The R 2,7 million community infrastructure created employment opportunities for at least 20 residents in this village. Speaking on

behalf of the residents, Mr Price Maxabiso Guqa, said, "We cannot be more pleased with the construction of this facility. We had many consultations with the Municipality regarding the progress of this hall and we are happy that no delays were experienced. The safety of this community hall is in our hands", concluded Guqa. The Municipality intends to hand-over two-more (2) community halls over the next coming weeks.

Eliphulo belikhokhelwe ngu Sodolophu obambelyo u ceba Inga Nodali ekwakunye noo ceba nabasebenzi balo masipala. Lo ka Nodali uchaze wathi "singuMasipala kulyanga yeSiliMela sihlonipha sikwa bhiyozela inyanga Yokusingqongileyo 'Environment month nesithe sathabatha igxathu singu Masipala ukufundisa abantu kwakunye nabantwana besikolo ngokubaluleka kwezinto esisingqon-

gileyo. Yilento umasipala ethe weza apha namhlanje ezokufundisa abantu abasebenzia nabashishina apha ePhakade ingakumbi indlela esisebenza ngayo esisakhiwo awathi umasipala wosokha apha". Izinto ezizakuthi zenziwe kolulakhiwo kwesisigaba sokuqala kukudilizwa komhlaba kwensiwe kubelitafa khona ukuze kubo lula ukuqaliswa kwalomsebenzi. Igama lika nokhontilakha ozqhuba lomsebenzi yi "Nkwali AMJV kugqityiwe".

Izinto ekulindeleke zenziwe kwesisigaba ziquka, ukufakelwa komgangatho wokuhamba abantu, retaing idonga lokunqan-

da amanzi kwakunye nokutyalwa kwengca ebeleni lokudlala ibhola. Igama lika nokhontilaka othe wanikezelwa kubahlali balo mmandla yi "Ntlangula 86 Trading" Ngokwemisebenzi kuzombini eziProjekthi kulindeleke ukuba kuqashiwe abantu basekuhlaleni ekuquka kubo amanina, ulutsha, abantu abangootata kunye nabakhbazwkileyo.

Ukuthatha inxaxheba koluntu lunegelelo kwiziqqibo ezingcono, kuba abasemagunyeni bathi zebakwazi ukwenza iziqqibo ezingcono babenolwazi olupheleleyo ngezingo zoluntu. Ebebambele uSodolophu uCllr Ntombizandile Garane uvule lendibano ngelithi "Ukuthatha inxaxheba yoluntu yinkubo enika abantu

ithuba lokuphembelela nokuphefumla kwiziqqibo zelizwe liphe-la kwaye kudala lonto iyinxalenye yoMzantsi Afrika sokela saba lilizwe lenkululeko".

Amasebe karhulumente athe ayinxalenye yolutyelelo aquka isebe uCOGTA, Isebe Lezothutho, Isebe lokuhlalisa kwabantu, Isebe lezemfundo, Isebe lezempilo, iqumrhu u Independent Electoral Commission (IEC) kanye no SAPS. Le ngqubo ithe yavula ingxoxo phakathi kwabahlali bale wardi bavakalisa izikalazo zabo

kulamasebe ohlukeneyo ka rhulumente. Phakathi kwezinto ebezithisa ibunzi ngumba wabantwana abangena zazisi zokuzalwa, abantu abadala abangena zazisi kwakunye abantwana abangayi esikolweni. Ukanti ulwaphulo mthetho, izikolo ezingeko semgangatweni wokufundela abantwana, kwakunye non-gafumani inkonzo zempilo yenye yemiba ethe yashukuxwa kulendibano. COMMUNITIES IN UMZIMVUBU WELCOME MORE THAN 50 MILLION SET-ASIDE FOR ROAD INFRASTRUCTURE.

The Municipality has set aside an amount of R55 million towards infrastructure projects for the 2023/2024 Financial Year. This was announced by the Mayor, Cllr Zukiswa Ndevu, during the Annual Service Delivery IMBIZO at Luyengweni Village, Ward 24 in KwaBhaca. The Municipal Infrastructure Grant (MIG) funded

initiative will see the Municipality improve in terms of road infrastructure. During her speech, the Mayor also mentioned that labour intensive employment opportunities were created during this financial year. "We were fortunate enough to have met most of our infrastructure obligations during this financial year. This, whereby we have also

managed to create more than 220 employment opportunities since the start of these projects", said Cllr Ndevu. Communities were further granted the opportunity to pose questions and comment further on the Mayors maiden speech. During the commentary session, communities applauded the ULM's commitment towards connect-

ing 700 households to the ESKOM gridline. This, after an amount of 17 million rand was allocated to the Municipality from the Integrated National Electrification Programme (INEP). The Municipality received more accolades when the Mayor said, "although it is mandated for the Department of Human Settlements to build houses, the

Municipality has adopted this approach to assist the most vulnerable families in its communities. Umzimvubu Local Municipality has been appointed by the Human Settlement Department as an implementing agent to construct RDP's to the value of R152 million for two consecutive years 2023/24 and 2024/25", concluded Cllr Ndevu.

Lenqubo yathi yathatha intsuku ezimbini kunikezelwa kwabo ban-

gathathi ntweni ngezinto ezizidingo zabo ezingudo-qo. Umasipala wasekuhlale-ni Umzimvubu ngomhla wesihlanu kwinyanga ka-Canzibe kulo umyo unyaka, uthe wabamba iintlanganiso enikezelwa ngokusesikweni ngoonokhontila-ka bokwakha iiprojekthi ezimbini EmaXesibeni.

Eziprojekthi zimbini yiMulti-Pur-pose Center ekwidolophu yase EmaXesibeni kwakunye ne projekti yolkwakhiwo lwezindlu zesibonelelo zase Cabazana. I Multi-Purpose Centre kulindeleke ukuba isun-

gule isigaba sesihlanu solwakhiwo esixabiso imali engaphaya kwezi-gidi ezine zerandi (4 million). Esisigaba sizakuthi siquke uk-wenziwa kwezindlu zangasese, indawo yezixhobo zemidlalo yan-gaphakathi kwakunye nokubiywa kwestisakhiwo .Kwicala lemisenbenzi baqikelewa kwishumi elinesi-hlanu abantu abazakuthi bafu-mane izithuba zomsebenzi. Ukanti kulwakhiwo lwezindlu zase Cabazana, zilali ezintlanu ekulin-deleke ukuba zokhelwe izindlu

ezilikhulu elinamashumi asib-hozo ananye 181, eziquka kuzo ilali iSolani, iMmangweni, iP-hutukezi, iMrholweni kunye ne Mnambithi. Lomsebenzi uzakuthi uxabise imali ebalelwu kwizigi-di ezingamashumi amathathu (30 million) kwaye nabantu balo mmandla bazakuxhamla ngok-wemisebenzi. USodolophu uCeba Zukiswa Ndevu nobekhokhele esisigqeba salomasipala, ukhuthaze onok-hontilaka ukuba benze umseben-

zi osemgangathweni kwakunye nabahlali ukuba babeliliso kwi-indawo ekuzakuthi kubekwe kuzo izixhobo zokusebenza ukunqanda ukilibaziseka nokuqhoba kwezi projekti, uyakwabongoze abahlali ebaxelela ukuba baze baphathane kakuhle nonoKhontilaka kwaye bamanyane ukulwa ubusela. Lo kaNdevu unikezele nakoonokhon-tilaka ithuba lokuzazisa ebaahlalini kwaye bachaze nendlela abaza-kuthi basebenze ngayo.

Umzimvulu Local Municipality on the 6th of June 2023, convened a meeting with Ward 8 residents at Lugelweni village in EmaXesibeni to handover a contractor that will be responsible for the upgrading of Lugelweni internal road.

Cllr Ntombizandile Garane, the Portfolio head of Infrastructure and Planning accompanied by the ward councillor and municipal officials handed over the project valued

over R 1,5 million. The project is set to take a duration of 6 months, commencing on the 15 June 2023. A minimum of 10 local labour and skilled labour will be employed for the duration of the project. People who will be employed in this project include amongst them females, males, youth and atleast one or two disabled people. The contractor responsible for the project is Ngcombela Civils and Plant Hire.

The scope of the project includes the maintenance of 4,8 km long gravel road, the construction will also include mass earthworks and road layer works.

Cllr Garane pleaded with the community to elect a project stirring committee within 7 days following the handover meeting. Garane further urged the community to unite in welcoming service delivery and should not fight amongst themselves as this will hinder the

progress of this project and development as planned by Umzimvulu in the current financial year. She encouraged the contractor to do quality work as well as residents to monitor the areas where equipment will be installed to prevent delays and running of these projects. She also gave the contractors the opportunity to introduce themselves to residents and also explain how they will work with them.

ed that they should know it's a scam when: - they are requested to call the sender on their mobile phones because the municipality does not request to be called back by bidders. - potential victims are required to make a payment fee in advance because the municipality does not request bidders to pay monies to individuals in any way whatsoever.

UMZIMVUBU LOCAL MUNICIPALITY IN A BID TO IMPROVE THE ECO-SYSTEM THROUGH THE DONGA REHABILITATION PROGRAMME.

During the 2022/2023 financial year, Umzimvubu Local Municipality carried out the implementation of the Donga Rehabilitation programme across KwaBhaca and EmaXesibeni. The Municipality appointed a service provider to identify and further eradicate large dongas that formed along the road which posed a significant public safety risk.

The dongas have also become sites for pollution and have resulted in siltation of the river due to soil erosion. The aim of the Donga Rehabilitation project is to rehabilitate the damage caused by soil erosion in the area. Since the establish-

ment of this project, the Municipality has been able to employ a minimum of 35 individuals at Cabazana, Lugelweni and Nqalweni.

The year-long project promises a good return on investment as it would improve the status and functioning of the freshwater ecosystem. This would further improve water quality and quantity as well as enhance public safety through the installation of disaster risk preventative infrastructure. The 1-million-rand investment is predominately rural and expected to be complete by the end of June 2023.

During the Service Delivery IMBIZO held in KwaBhaca on the 26th May 2023, Umzimvubu Mayor, Cllr Zukiswa Ndevu welcomed the R17 million fund injection from the Integrated National Electrification Programme (INEP) for the upcoming 2023/2024 Financial Year (FY). INEP is a government initiative aimed to provide capital subsidies to municipalities to address

the electrification backlog of permanently occupied residential dwellings.

The purpose of the INEP is to manage the electrification planning, funding, and implementation process with the aim of addressing electrification backlogs. In her statement, the Mayor emphasised that government has a responsibility to ensure the electrification of all its citizens, par-

ticularly, in rural areas, uplift the people and make life more convenient. During the 2022/2023 financial year, the Municipality managed to connect at least 254 households to the ESKOM grid-line.

The Mayor further called for patience during this period, as the Municipality works towards the electrification of all households. "I want to plead with the community

to remain patient during this period as we continue to reduce our electrification backlog. We are in talks with Eskom to speed up the energising process of all completed electricity projects," said Cllr Ndevu. The Municipality remains confident in its bid to continue connecting households and to alleviate the existing backlog.
