TERMS OF REFERENCE

It is the intention of the Umzimvubu Local Municipality to enter into a formal contract with a service provider that will carry out the services described hereunder. These specifications and the service provider's proposal will form the basis of the contract.

SECTION 1: PROJECT TITLE

SECTION 2: SUMMARY OF BRIEF

Proposals are being requested, from service providers who have experience and qualifications in Agriculture, Animal production, Animal Health, crop production or experience on farm management systems on how best can mentor Umzimvubu farmers. The service provider will assist in running of the projects which are situated at Mount Frere and Mount Ayliff villages respectively. The Service Provider will be responsible with the following: Mentoring of 20 Umzimvubu farmers, 10 farmers from Mount Frere and 10 farmers from Mount Ayliff from the following wards, 01, 02, 03, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 19, 21, 22, 23, 24, 26 and 27. The service provider will be responsible to conduct skills transfer to the beneficiaries and draft monthly reports, as part of the ULM exit strategy. The service provider is expected to put clear recommendations on how to improve the skills of these farmers.

SECTION 3: PROJECT DESCRIPTION

INTRODUCTION

Umzimvubu Local Municipality which falls under Alfred Nzo District Municipality has been identified as a rural node through the Integrated Sustainable Rural Development Programme (ISRDP) in 2001 which means that the area is poverty stricken characteristic of low levels of education, skill and therefore high levels of unemployment.

The municipality has identified 20 farmers with a potential to produce quality crops and livestock which will enable these farmers to produce commercially. The aim is to utilize locally available resources in achieving these aims. The locally available marketing opportunities for these products, will also help in boosting the production capacity of local Agricultural Co-operatives and contribute to the projects sustainability.

BACKGROUND

Umzimvubu area of jurisdiction has a great potential in agricultural produce weather is for crop production or the livestock.

The emerging Farmers at Mt Frere and Mt Ayliff have been practising a subsistence farming for so many years. The situation currently is not yet changed but the municipality is putting an effort to change the situation.

In order to reinvent the wheel, the emerging farmers need mentorship and business coaching. Linking them with the commercial farmers and markets will assist a great deal.

The wool production farmers need to be introduced to BKB and appropriate wool management skills are needed with proper market linkages.

3.1 PROJECT PURPOSE:

 To recommend / appoint a Service Provider who will enter in a lease agreement with the Municipality to mentor the identified farmers, do the skills transfer to the beneficiaries and link them with the relavent markets.

3.2 PROJECT OUTCOMES/ OUTPUTS/ DELIVERABLES

The following outcomes and deliverables are required:

- Giving technical support to the emerging farmers.
- To improve the quality of livestock.
- To improve the wool production/ quality for the Farmers.
- Empowerment of rural communities on animal keeping.
- Keeping livestock in good health even in winter.
- To link the wool Farmers with BKB and other relevant Institutions so as to optimize profits/ sales.

- Improving the crop production of the Farmers and be able to link farmers with relevant market or Umzimvubu Local Municipality fresh produce Market.
- Development of the vaccination programme for the farmers.
- The monthly report shall entail the following documents: Letter of intents from the local markets, attendance registers and report with pictures and video clips.

3.3 SCOPE OF WORKS.

The appointed service provider is expected to develop and submit the proposal. The proposal should include but not limited to the following:

- > The livestock improvement programme (Sheep, goat and cattle).
- > Wool management and production
- Vegetable production programme
- Poultry production programme
- > Pig production

The mentorship programme is as follows:

- 1. All the programmes are done on weekly basis and a full mentoring programme is put in place.
- 2. The farmers are visited as and when required but more and above that the visit programme is done on weekly basis.
- 3. Visit schedule must be attached in every report, pictures of current scenario and after video clips and attendance registers.

The successful service provider is expected to assit the farmers to find the relevant markets to sell their products. Therefore the letter of intents from the shops are expected to be submitted with the reports.

3.4 COMPETENCY / EXPERTISE REQUIREMENTS

In order to complete this task the following expertise and competencies deemed necessary.

- 1. The service provider must have a proven record of functionality in the field of Animal production, crop production or experience on farm management systems.
- 2. Experience on working with the local farmers.
- 3. Knowledge of the Umzimvubu area of jurisdiction.
- 4. Facilitation / co-ordination skills
- 5. Report writing and presentation skills as an added advantage.
- 6. Experience and knowledge in undertaking and completing similar assignments
- 7. Be able to work in partnership with the Municipality
- 8. Able to use participatory learning approach.

9. Ability to start immediately after the appointment and carry out the process on a sustained basis until completion within the stipulated time.

 For project management purposes the service provider will report to the LED/Agriculture Development Officer, Umzimvubu LM. For substantive issues.
