RENOVATIONS OF BHONGWENI HOSTEL BID NO.: GKM 42-17/18

The Greater Kokstad Municipality hereby invites proposals from service providers registered with NHBRC and CIDB grading of 4GB or higher.

The comprehensive scope and bid requirements are encapsulated in the bid document.

Evaluation will be done on the following two-stage process in terms of National Treasury Circular No. 53.

Stage 1: Assessment of functionality. Only service providers who achieve a minimum of 60% of the total available points will qualify for stage two of the Evaluation process. Functionality criteria is as follows.

- Company Experience (40points)
- Qualification & Experience of Site Agent & Foreman (40 points)
- Bank Rating (20 points)

Stage 2: The 80/20 preferential point system will be applied, where 80 points will be allocated for price and 20 points for B-BBEE Status. Bidders must submit a certified certificate issued by an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the CCA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS, Registered Auditor or sworn affidavit to claim preference points. Failure to submit BBBEE Certificate will result in the loss of points. **Proof of registration with CIDB is required.**

A NON-REFUNDABLE Bid documents fee of R500.00 per document is payable in cash at the Municipality's Customer Care Centre.
