This communiqué serves to request your office to solicit quotes from suitable service providers for the drawing of a plan and specification for the improvement of Mount Frere animal pound.

Drawing of the plan:

Community Safety is seeking bids from qualified architects for the drawing of a plan and specifications for the improvement of the existing Mount Frere stray animal pound in Sophia. The existing pound is obsolete and does not meet the guidelines of care for a municipal animal pound as prescribed by the state. The existing shelter does not have adequate space to house and exercise the number of stray and impounded animals received by the pound. In addition, there are no proper isolation areas to separate animals. Sick animals, quarantined animals require additional isolated areas which the current shelter does not have. Additional space needs have been identified for the extension of the pound. Additional shelters and feeding places and a dipping tank need to be added. Pound must be divided into camps for different species of livestock in order that they do not mix when they are in the yard.

The purpose of the drawing of the plan and improvement is to make the pound a registered pound that meets all requirements. The pound is for impounding or sheltering all seized, stray, homeless, abandoned, unwanted or surrendered livestock within Umzimvubu Local Municipality. The pound design should optimizes use of the site, minimizes construction costs and impacts to the environment, and ensures that the improvements blends well into the existing pound.
