BACKGROUND

The accumulation in volumes of the waste is due in part to the fact that way before the site hand over back to the Municipality by the contractor (Coalition Trading) on the 4th of July 2018 until to date the 26th of July 2018 vehicles were/and are still dispose of waste at their own discretion and anywhere, albeit in the area designated. As a result, from then and currently the waste not properly managed, compacted and covered on regular basis. The waste is currently scattered in cell 2 and the immediate surrounding.
