Umzimvubu Local Municipality is embarking on a training program for developing contractors in construction, supervising under the auspices of the Contractor Development Program. The objective of this programme is to develop emerging contractors into sustainable construction with the ability to execute and oversee labour intensive construction projects. Particular attention will be given to developing entrepreneurial, management and technical skills. Our first interest is in historically disadvantaged people who have the potential to succeed in the construction industry.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Prospective contracting entity must

- Be registered as a construction entity (company/close corporation) with CIPC (Company Intellectual Property Commission)
- Be in possession of SARS Tax Compliance Status (TCS) Pin Number
- Be Registered with CIDB for a period not less than 1 year, in Civil Engineering (CE, GB and SQ, SK, EP) Category on Grade 1 & 2.
- Preference is given to entities classified as Affirmable Business Enterprise (ABE) & SMME in CIDB Grade 1 & 2
- A total of 30 contractors will appointed across the local municipality
- Entities will be selected on a basis that work will be fairly and equitably distributed amongst contracting entities
- Women and disabled people are encouraged to apply
- The programme will be more than 50% female dominant
- Compulsory submission of CV with academic certificates or reports
- Failure to fill in application forms properly will result to disqualification
- Detailed Company Profile with all relevant experience

- Be willing to enter into a full-time (minimum 24 months) development contract for construction contractors at NQF Level 4

- Material should be sourced locally (within South African borders)
- Company registration document must reflect Mount Ayliff or Mount Frere address
- Proof of registration on the National Centralized Supplier Database (CSD). Only suppliers who are registered on CSD will be considered for appointment.
- Company registration documents that reflects Umzimvubu Local Municipal jurisdiction (Mount Ayliff and Mount Frere)
- Certified ID copies of Directors or Owners of the company
- Bidders must include copy of CIDB or CRS numbers

- Recommended bidders will be subject to supplier security screening processes. Only suppliers who obtain security clearance will be considered for appointment.
- Potential suppliers must note that in terms of Umzimvubu Local Municipality policy, the municipality reserves the right to cancel a contract and blacklist any supplier for a period of at least 12 months if the supplier fails to adequately perform in terms of the awarded contract.
