TERMS OF REFERENCES

FOR

THE SUPPLY AND DELIVER IDEGENOUS CHICKENS

1. Introduction:

- Umzimvubu Local Municipality LED Department has the 5 areas of performance of which one of them is Environmental Management.
- The Local Economic Development (LED) Department has a responsibility of ensuring and promoting clean environment through reduction of gas emissions. It has a responsibility also to ensure the utilization of local available resource for the improvement of livelihoods.
- Umzimvubu local Municipality is embarking on a bio-gas as an alternative energy for both cooking and heating.
- The aim is to promote the use of locally available resources for betterment of Rural Livelihoods.
- Umzimvubu Local Municipality therefore is looking for a service provider to supply and deliver of indigenous birds and suitable feed, training of beneficiaries and after care services in Ward 26 Cabazana Village of Umzimvubu Local Municipality.

- a. Umzimvubu Local Municipality is therefore looking for service provider to supply and deliver indigenous chickens and conduct 2 day training on basic indigenous chickens in Ward 26 Cabazana Village of Umzimvubu Local Municipality.

4. SCOPE OF WORK

- Supply and deliver 100 indigenous birds for Cabazana Poultry project (ward 26)
- Supply should consider buying from Local farmers, since local fowls are adoptive to local environment.
- Be vaccinated against gumboro and Newcastle diseases.
- Be at least 8months old but not older than 2 years of age.
- Number of hens mixed breed but still indigenous 94.
- 6 roosters (2 Rhode Island Red, 2 buff red or koekoeks.
- Supply and appropriate feed for the birds that can sustain feeding for 3 months.
- Supply must provide after care service for at minimum of 3 months.
- The appointed service provider is expected to provide with saw dust and 2-3 day basic management skills before the arrival of the chickens.
