## OPERATION CLEAN AUDIT READINESS ASSESSMENT

## BACKGROUND

Umzimvubu Local Municipality falls within the Alfred Nzo District of the Eastern Cape Province. Umzimvubu Municipality has been through the strides to improve the state of accountability having been obtaining unqualified audit opinions for the past 4 years.

To improve on this the Municipality is seeking the services of a suitably qualified consultant to assist the Municipality in the year end procedures with an aim of achieving clean administration. The roles and responsibilities of the consultant will be to conduct a risk based year-end readiness assessment and year end program that will set the Municipality on a path towards clean audit. This process will have the following key deliverables;
