The service provider will assist in running of the projects which are situated at Mount Frere and Mount Ayliff villages respectively. The Service Provider will be responsible with the following: Mentoring of 20 Umzimvubu farmers, 16 farmers from Mount Frere and 4 farmers from Mount Ayliff from the following wards, 3,4,5,9,11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19,21,25 and 27. The service provider will be responsible to conduct skills transfer to the beneficiaries and draft monthly reports, as part of the ULM exit strategy. The service provider is expected to put clear recommendations on how to improve the skills of these farmers.

SECTION 3: PROJECT DESCRIPTION

INTRODUCTION

Umzimvubu Local Municipality which falls under Alfred Nzo District Municipality has been identified as a rural node through the Integrated Sustainable Rural Development Programme (ISRDP) in 2001 which means that the area is poverty stricken characteristic of low levels of education, skill and therefore high levels of unemployment.

The municipality has identified 20 farmers with a potential to produce quality crops and livestock which will enable these farmers to produce commercially. The aim is to utilize locally available resources in achieving these aims. The locally available marketing opportunities for these products, will also help in boosting the production capacity of local Agricultural Co-operatives and contribute to the projects sustainability.

BACKGROUND

Umzimvubu area of jurisdiction has a great potential in agricultural produce weather is for crop production or the livestock.

The emerging Farmers at Mt Frere and Mt Ayliff have been practising a subsistence farming for so many years. The situation currently not yet changed but the municipality is putting an effort to change the situation.

In order to reinvent the wheel, the emerging farmers need mentorship and business coaching. Linking them with the commercial farmers and markets will assist a great deal.

The wool farmers need to be introduced to BKB and appropriate wool management skills are needed with proper market linkages.
